What is compost and why soil needs it

By the end of the lesson, the learner should be able to: a) explain what compost manure is; b) explain why soil needs organic matter added to it

Compost manure

Compost is manure made by letting plant and kitchen waste rot (decompose) into a dark, crumbly material full of nutrients that plants need to grow well.
