By the end of the lesson, the learner should be able to read the selected hadith on the character of the Prophet as a role model

The Prophet as a model of good character

A hadith is a recorded saying or teaching of Prophet Muhammad (S.A.W.). Among the most well-known teachings about character is that the Prophet described the best among believers as those with the best character (akhlaq), and that he himself was sent to perfect good character.
